Kosrae is known for its virgin reef and pristine waters, visibility up to 200+ ft. and thriving hard coral society. More than 50 dive sites have been identified by local diving pioneers. Each has been marked with a buoy to prevent improper anchoring, leaving Kosrae's reefs pristine and ripe for exploration. Nearly all Micronesians are Christian. Yapese are mostly Catholic, Kosraeans mostly Protestant, and Pohnpeians and Chuukese divided. Eight languages are spoken in the FSM: Chuukese, Kosraean, Kapingamarangi, Nukuoran, Pohnpeian, Ulithian, Woleaian, and Yapese. English has become the common language.
